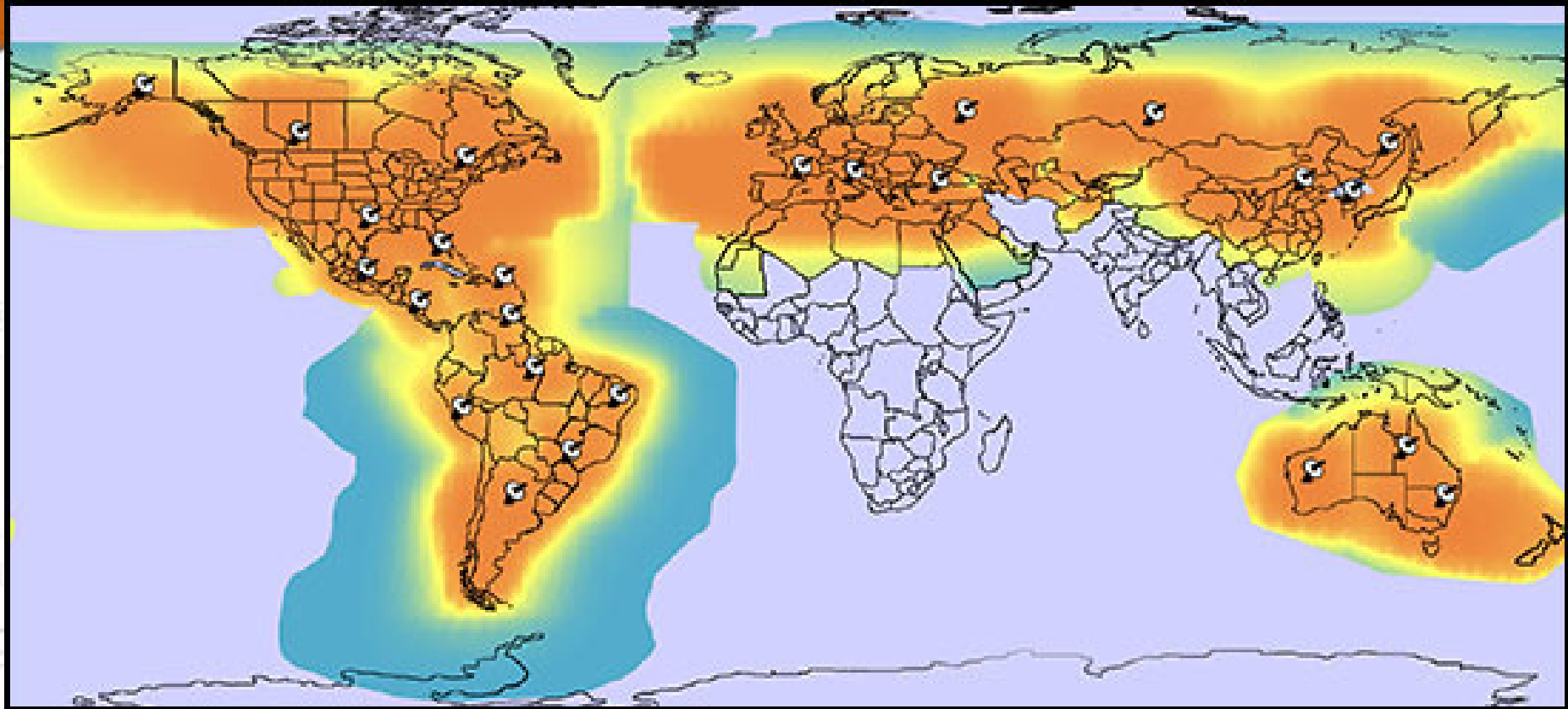

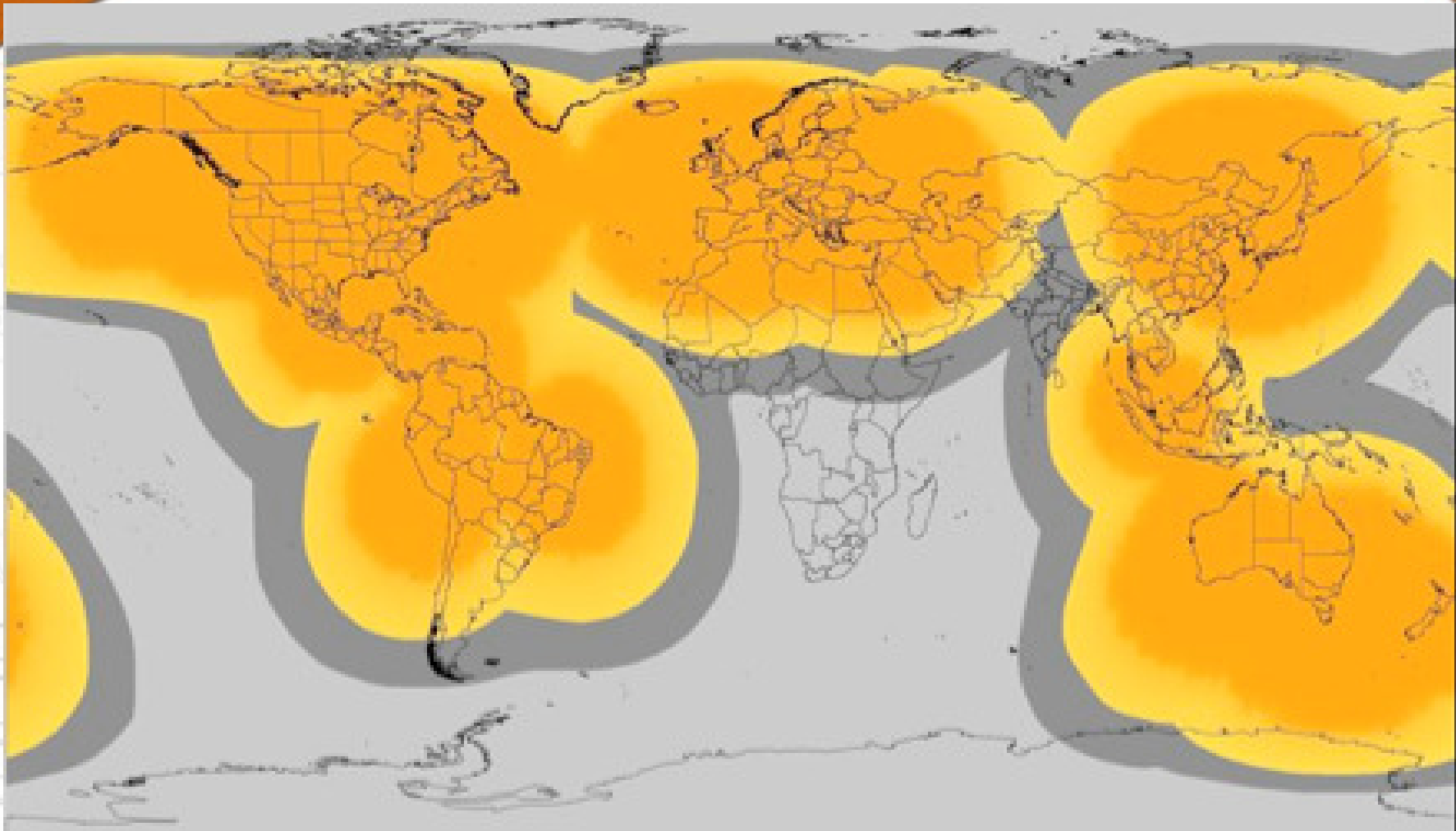


Voice & Duplex Coverage

How does it work?

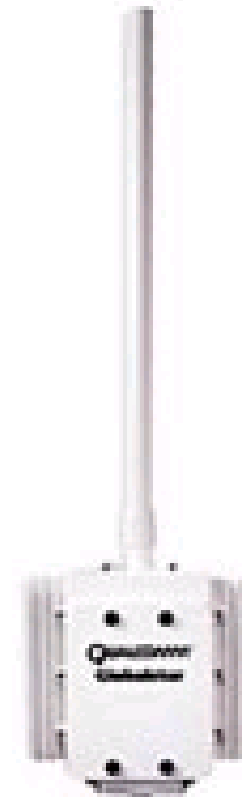


Best Practice Use Cases

- **Remote Telecommunications capability**
 - Mobile and Fixed communications for Voice and Email even when there is no GSM coverage
 - Hub & Spoke system to support Command centres and remote outposts
- **Equipment Tracking & monitoring**
 - Monitoring of location and status of key equipment almost everywhere in the world
 - Live tracking of deliveries eg. Food Convoys
 - Geographical fencing to stop equipment going missing
- **Personnel communications & tracking**
 - Stay in contact in Remote locations
 - Low cost individual messaging capability
 - Track and ensure safety of every team member

CHECK IN - Let your contacts know all is well, or save waypoints for review at a later date. A user-programmable message, as well as your GPS location with a link to Google Maps™, will be sent to your contacts via text and/or email.



TRACK PROGRESS - Send your GPS location to your SPOT account every 10 minutes for 24 hours so your contacts can follow your progress in real time, or to save waypoints so you can view your full route at a later date.



HELP - For non-life-threatening situations, SPOT will automatically determine your coordinates and send your help message, as well as your GPS location with a link to Google Maps™, via text message and/or email every 5 minutes for 1 hour.



SOS - For critical emergencies, a distress signal will be sent every 5 minutes until cancelled and emergency responders will be dispatched to your GPS location.
